Bureau of Indian Education

Day Type Unlocked in Attribute Dictionary (SIS-14426)

Day Type has been unlocked within the Attribute Dictionary. Users are now allowed to add additional Day Type attributes.

NOTE: This change only affects District Editions of Campus for BIE schools in New Mexico

State Enrollment Overlap Report - Display of Overlaps (SIS-15313)

The State Enrollment Overlap Report was not properly displaying students who had overlapping enrollments on the District Edition report results. This has been corrected.

BIE 30 Day Residential Attendance Report Modifications (SIS-15538)

Modifications have been made to the BIE 30 Day Residential Attendance Report. This report link has been removed from State Edition sites as the attendance detail is not available on the State Edition. All instances of BIE 30 Days Residential Attendance Report within the product have been corrected to BIE 30 Day Residential Attendance Report.

Calendar Type Codes Added (SIS-15701)

Two Calendar Type codes have been added. Codes F: FACE and 21: 21st Century have been added.

BIE - Validation Report Calendar Error (SIS-16116)

The BIE Validation Report - Calendar Validation was returning an error message when generated using SLQ 2000. This has been corrected.

BIE Absent Days Field Updated to Display Exact Calculation Absent Days (SIS-10422)

The BIE Absent Days field has been modified to a read-only display of the exact calculation of absent days. This field will now nightly calculate attendance on District Editions and sync to NASIS State Editions using the Task Scheduler. Users also have the option of manually triggering a calculation and sync to the State Edition by selecting the AttendanceBIEAbsentDays Resync Option on the Resync State Data tool. State Edition ADM and ADA Report has been updated to now pull absent days data from this field and not the geographic state absent days field.

Class Rank in End of Year End Statuses for BIE (SIS-12651)

Class Rank was failing to populated for End of Year end statuses. To correct this issue, end status values that are not withdrawals in BIE have been set to 1 so that these students are not excluded from class rank calculations. The Campus Dictionary has been updated with the following additions:

Regional Code Mapping Removed from System Administration (SIS-16212)

Regional code mapping has been removed from System Administration. BIE Event Code Mapping and BIE Resolution Code Mapping fields have been removed from the Campus user interface. This change only affects BIE District Editions of Campus.

Records Transfer - Special Education Documents (SIS-16522)

The following issues have been corrected in relation to the importing of Special Education documents:

- The IEP link in the transfer documents will now direct users to the IEP import screens.
- The Evaluation type field on the Special Education Evaluation Import Wizard screen is now populated with appropriate items.
- The PDF function for importing IEPs now displays a save button.
- Data will now be imported when the Next button is selected, advancing the wizard to the completion step.

ISEP Dates Tab and ISEP Allotment Report (SIS-16713)

The following modifications have been made to ISEP:

- The ISEP Dates tab has been renamed to be ISEP Management tab. Verbiage has been added providing information on how to use the tab.
- A Residential Type field has been added to the ISEP Management tab. This is a dropdown list with 3 options - Null, 4 Nights or 5-7 Nights.
- An Isolation Factor checkbox has been added.
- A School Board Training checkbox has been added.
- All new fields will display for all BIE schools on State Edition and District Edition.
- All new fields can be edited in State Edition, but are read-only in District Edition.

With this change, the ISEP Dates table structure has been modified. The ISEP Residential Verification and Certification Report has been updated to use the new ISEP dates table structure.

Geographic to BIE SPED Comparison (SIS-16814)

The Geographic State to BIE SPED comparison validation has been removed. This validation assumed all geographic states use null to signify not receiving special education, but several states use other values, meaning the validation report was returning false warnings.

Ad hoc Reporting

Student.activeToday Ad hoc Field Not End Date Inclusive (SIS-7319)

The Student.activeToday Ad hoc field was not counting students as active if their last day of enrollment was the day being generated for the report or the student had a future enrollment end date. This has been corrected.

NOTE: student.activeToday means the student must have an active enrollment record on the current date (i.e., the date for which the report is being generated).

Roster Summary Missing Grade Levels in Ad hoc (SIS-7352)

The Roster Summary field in Ad hoc was incorrectly only pulling data for grades 6-12. This has been corrected. Roster Summary now displays data for grades KG-12.

Custom Tab Checkboxes Incorrectly Displaying as True/False when Generated in Ad hoc Reports (SIS-10617)

Custom tab checkboxes were incorrectly saving as true/false in the database and displaying true/false when generated in Ad hoc reports. This has been corrected. Custom checkboxes now save and display as 0/1, where 0 is false, 1 is true.

Filter Designer - Proficiency Levels and Assessment Data Elements (SIS-15994)

Data elements used in Proficiency Levels and Assessments have now been added to the Filter Designer. The following elements are now available:

Assessment

Assessments - Parent/Child Display (SIS-6724)

The following modifications have been made to assessment display for a student:

- Four generations of assessments are now possible in the tree structure of an assessment. This matches the functionality of the Score Import Wizard.
- The fields on the child test will now sequence the same as the parent test.
- A visual reference has been added to easily recognize what assessment is currently being viewed and modified by having the test in the tree structure remain open.
- The detail view of any test will show that test and the child tests associated with it.
- More space has been added to the Assessment title view and now appears in darker text color.

Score Import Wizard - Null Pointer Error (SIS-17002)

The Score Import Wizard returned an error message when a field such as state ID or Social Security number is blank in the Demographics area. This has been corrected.

Score Import Wizard Functionality Change (SIS-15929)

Functionality was changed for the Score Import Wizard in 2010.1 to not allow importing of records containing errors. Due to customer request, this functionality has been removed and the previous functionality has been reimplemented. Users can now import records containing errors and manually correct those errors after the file has been uploaded.

Score Import Wizard Not Importing Records Containing Blank Fields (SIS-16145)

The Score Import Wizard would error out and not import any records containing a blank or null field. Once the wizard hit a blank field, the importing process would stop and no records would import. This has been corrected. Score Import Wizard will now pass over blank fields and continue the importing process successfully.

Attendance

Consecutive Absence Report - Grade Display (SIS-11009)

The Consecutive Absence Report was not correctly displaying student grade levels when the grade level selection is set to All Grades on the Report editor. This has been corrected.

Attendance Classroom Monitor - Historical Display (SIS-16769)

The Attendance Classroom Monitor was not displaying historical data if the district had attendance information entered prior to the 0931 Patch Bundle. This has been corrected. All attendance data will now display properly on the Classroom Monitor.

Attendance Letter Generation - Schedule Structures (SIS-16179)

The Attendance Letters were found to be ignoring selected schedule structures in the Campus toolbar. This has been corrected. Attendance letters now have the ability to be schedule structure-specific and the list of sections available to the user will change based on the selected schedule structure.

For best performance, always enter a weight and trigger value.

Behavior

Behavior Letter Wizard Updates (SIS-12257)

A number of updates have been made to the Behavior Letter Wizard in an effort to correct previous issues as well as improve the overall usability. The following is a list of updates made:

- Event Count is no longer a required field. Leaving this field blank will look for any number of events in correlation with trigger criteria selected.
- When using Campus fields, only events meeting the trigger criteria during the date range or effective date entered will be included.
- Show Role is now an available option for inclusion within the Discipline Summary Sub-report.
- Blank Form Letter is now an available Letter Format. This allows users to generate letters that do not have guardian or school address information listed.
- Addressed Form Letter now generates letters which display address information to fit a standard window envelope.
- Users who select Address Form Letter are also now able to include a salutation within the new Salutation Line field. Salutations written here appear at the beginning of the address seen within the envelope window.
- Ad hoc Filter capability has been added to the Behavior Letter Wizard. Users may now generate behavior letters based on specific Ad hoc filters created.
- Users are now able to designate the Event Resolution as the date which is pulled by the wizard.
- Users are now able to filter trigger criteria based on Role. This option allows users to search and generate behavior letters based on the role a student played in the behavior event.
- New Sub-Report Options have been created. The following describes new options available:
- All events matching the criteria selected for the date range - All events of the type selected with the resolution and role specified from the beginning of the calendar year to the date (last day of date range) selected will be included within the sub-report.
- Trigger Event only - Only the event which triggered the count to be met will be included within the sub-report.

- All behavior events in the date range - All behavior events which occurred from the beginning of the calendar year to the date selected (last day of date range) will be included within the sub-report.

Census

Dialogue Box Added when Household Membership is Deleted (SIS-14908)

A dialogue box has been added to appear when users attempt to delete a household membership. This box will provide the user will three options:

- Keep the relationships.
- End the relationships by adding an end date. A date field is available, pre-populated with the current date.
- Delete the relationships. This will leave no historical record of the deleted relationships.
- Users will encounter this dialogue box under the following scenarios:
 - User deleted a household membership from the Census > People > Households tab.
 - User ends a household membership from the Census > People > Households tab.
 - User deleted a household membership from the Census > Households > Members tab.
 - User ends a household membership from the Census > Households > Members tab.
 - User enters and end date for a household member and navigates away from the page without saving.

Census Wizard - Household Membership Deletion (SIS-16155)

When using the Census Wizard, it was discovered that clicking the X next to a person's name only removed the person from the household in Step 1, but still remained in Step 2. This has been corrected. The membership that was deleted from the household will remain deleted until the user adds that membership again.

The home phone number was not printing on the Person Summary Report for non household member contacts. This has been corrected.

Details Link when Performing a Person Search (SIS-14769)

The Detail link in the Add Person, Add Household Member and New Non-Household Relationship searches has new formatting to better indicate that it is a link. The link has also been added to the Census Wizard search results for people who are not in a household. This link, when selected, will bring up the Person Summary Report which provides information such as phone number and email address for easy access.

Modifications Made to My Data (SIS-14151)

A number of modifications have been made to the My Data tool. The following is a list of updates made:

- Action buttons were updated on each tab within My Data. Users are now given two buttons, one for requesting a new record and a second button for requesting an update to an existing record.

- The Household Information window has changed. Current records now appear at the top, pending requests appear in a separate Pending Requests collapsible folder and processed requests appear within a separate Processed Requests collapsible folder.
- Records within the Household information window now remain highlighted if an update request is made on the record. This highlight is removed when a new record is requested.
- Information deemed as Read-Only now displays a message at the top of the editor stating “Read Only (create and update request to change data)”
- The Request List dropdown list now displays the correct amount of pending, approved and denied requests.
- Searching for addresses now presents a message to users if no results were returned stating they should close the search box to enter a new address.
- A Geocode verification has been added to address requests. Addresses now must pass this verification to be allowed within a request.
- Users who select a request within the process inbox are now redirected directly to the request with updated fields highlighted.
- Comments entered in requests now display.
- The Person Summary Report was displaying an older version of the report. This has been corrected.

MyData - Highly Qualified Credentials (SIS-17880)

An error message was returned when approving requests to change highly qualified credentials using the Request Processor. This has been corrected.

State Enrollment Verification (SIS-18004)

The State Enrollment Verification report is now available in the Student Information Reports section. This report is used to identify students who have enrollment overlaps. This report is only available in a District Edition linked to a State Edition.

An additional option has been added to the report to identify students missing at the state due to enrollment overlap prevention.

Additional modifications have been added for BIE users:

- The report will display and compare the geographic state start status instead of the BIE start status.
- Additional checkboxes have been added to the Report Editor: BIE Excluded, BIE Unmapped Grade Levels and BIE Grade Level.

Enrollment

Enrollment Cleanup Wizard Clarification (SIS-14920)

Users were reporting that the Enrollment Cleanup Wizard was incorrectly returning no enrollments to cleanup. This was not a functionality issue but a misunderstanding as to how the Enrollment Cleanup Wizard works.

To lessen confusion, the description above the Calendar list now states “Select the Calendar in which the student ended their enrollment.”

In addition to updating the Calendar description, the description for the Enrollment Cleanup Wizard editor has been updated as follows:

“This wizard will remove next year’s enrollments that were created using the Enrollment Roll Forward tool if either of the following is true:

- The student’s previous enrollment was ended prior to the last day of the previous calendar and the student has not re-enrolled in the same calendar and grade.
- The student fails to meet the Student Assignment requirements for next year’s enrollment.

Select the calendar in which the student ended their enrollment along with grade levels and service type. Run a test to preview the results before executing the cleanup action.”

Person Deletion - Graduation Dependency (SIS-16571)

Users were unable to delete a person if that person had a graduation record, however there was no way to delete a graduation record. This has been corrected. Upon creation of a high school enrollment record, a graduation record is automatically created. Conversely, when that person record is deleted, the graduation record will also be deleted.

Fees

Fee Adjustments (SIS-15304)

Fee logic has been modified to not allow the appearance of negative fees. Instead of entering a negative number to reduce the amount of the fee owed, users can now adjust the entered fee.

Following is a summary of modifications made:

- Only positive values can be entered in the Amount field when creating a new fee in System Administration.
- Only positive values can be entered in the Amount field on the student’s Fees tab.
- Adjustments allow users to add a credit to one or more fee assignments for both variable and fixed fees, but can only apply to a single fee.
- Adjustments are not allowed for Exempt fees.
- Adjustments are allowed on fees with a negative balance to address a situation where a student might have paid for an activity but dropped out of the activity before the end of the season. For this reason, adjustments can be made to indicate the portion that is owed.
- If a fee is marked as exempt after an adjustment has already been made to the fee, the adjustment will be removed.
- If a fee adjustment is deleted, any adjustments that apply to that fee will also be deleted.
- If an adjustment is made to a fee assignment, the adjusted fee amount will apply to the fee maximum, not the original fee amount.
- If there is an adjustment on a fee assignment and later the original fee amount is paid in full, this will result in a credit on the student’s account for that fee.
- Fee adjustments have been added to the Fee Receivables Report and the Fee Billing Batch Report.
- Fee adjustments appear on the Portal in the Fees section.
- When an adjustment is made that results in the fee having a negative balance a warning message will appear.

Fee Wizard Not Assigning Fees to Students with Future Enrollments (SIS-16800)

The Fee Wizard was unable to assign fees to students who did not have an active enrollment record. This issue was preventing schools from assigning fees to students with future enrollment records established. This has been corrected.

Fee Payment Fill - Cents Entry (SIS-16921)

When entering fee payments using the Fill option, cents were being incorrectly added. Modifications have been made to always fill cents as entered and logic has been adjusted to record entered money in standard money format.

Food Service

Duplicate Persons with POS Account Unable to be Deleted (SIS-17178)

Users were unable to delete duplicate people within Campus if the person had a POS account. This has been corrected. Duplicate persons are able to be deleted as long as they do not have existing information for the following:

- Current or historical transaction data
- Eligibility tied to an application
- FRAM application

FRAM Verification and Letter Updates (SIS-8252)

The Verification Summary report and all Verification letters have been updated with the most recent USDA requirements. All references to food stamp have been changed to SNAP.

Logic on the Verification Summary report for the number of schools reported has been changed. Logic is now based on the schools assigned to a terminal. Each school assigned to a terminal indicates students who are eating in the in the district. Student enrollment records and school counts are now based off the schools assigned to a terminal. Users may view this information by selecting the Print All option from Point of Sale Terminals.

FRAM Verification Modifications (SIS-14579)

The following modifications have been made to the FRAM Verification process:

- An application was being replaced with the same application. If there are no applications remaining in the qualified sample to replace an application in the sample pool, an error message will appear upon save that indicates there are no applications remaining to replace the application.
- Additional applications were being populated in the sample increasing the sample size incorrectly. In certain situations when the Verification end date was added and saved an additional application was populating in the sample pool.
- The latest application was not being included in the generated sample. If a household had more than one application for the year the qualified file did not include the latest application, but was selecting the first application entered. Additional logic has been added to account for other multiple application situations that can occur.
- A FreeReducedVerificationPool table has been created that stores qualified applications for each verification year based on a verificationID. Once Verification is run for the year, the table stores the qualified applications that are used for the sample pool. If an application is amended, excluded or deleted after Verification is run for the year, the changed application will not be added to the table. The table is a snap shot of the applications on file as of the date Verification is run. This data should not be changed or removed.

- If a household has an income application for two children and a categorical application for another child on file, both of these applications will be included in the qualified pool. However, the household will only be verified once for both applications. If this situation occurs and this household is selected to be verified, the application reference number will be displayed in black font below the application reference number pulled for verification. This will indicate there are two applications on file for the same household that need to be reviewed. Since USDA allows a household to fill out one paper application with income and categorical children, vendors are allowed to process two applications for this scenario since it is not possible for an application to have two certified types. Based on a new USDA ruling dated 8/27/09, districts are now allowed to categorically certify all children in the household if there is at least one child with a case number, the situation described above should no longer occur.

FRAM Verification Display (SIS-15937)

The application approved date and the enrollment effective date fields are no longer editable.

The Application Detail view has been changed to a table view. A separation of error prone and non-error prone applications have been added. The table now also indicates how many total applications of each type are in the qualified pool and how many applications of each type are used in the sample pool.

FRAM Import Wizard Modifications (SIS-3192)

A number of modifications have made to the FRAM Import Wizard. The following lists all modifications made separated by Campus version as modifications are version-specific:

Campus 2009.2 and 2010.1

- Wording has been updated on the Import Wizard to now appropriately display as Food Service Import Wizard.
- An Exclude checkbox has been added. This is an optional feature that is not required for use. This checkbox will set an exclude flag on an application which will then omit the application from being included in the Verification process. An example of this is a district who receives the Direct Certification file after processing a number of applications for households where students are included in the Direct Certification file. These applications should not have been processed since the families are Directly Certified therefore the applications should not be included in the Verification since the households have already been verified by the State Agency. If the Exclude checkbox is used, the applications associated with students in the import file will have an exclude flag set and will not be included in the Verification process. If the Exclude checkbox is not used, districts can choose to manually delete or exclude applications for each of the households. If districts choose not to do this, applications will be included in the Verification process and potentially selected to be Verified.
- When a file was imported and a mismatch of data was found, the file would stop importing data beyond the point where the mismatch occurred and was not indicating this error within the Import Report. This has been corrected. Mismatched data will now report within the Import Report and the file will continue to import the remaining data.

Logic was updated upon Test or Import where the following occurs:

The Summary Section of the Import Report will now indicate the number of New, Ended, Removed and Existing eligibilities in the imported file as well as the number of Errors/Warnings existing in the file.

The Updated Records section on the Import Wizard will indicate a list of all student eligibilities from the source file that were updated in the database. There are three types of updated records:

New

- New indicates no current year eligibilities exist in the database. The new eligibility status from the source file is imported and the carry-over eligibility was appropriately ended the day prior to the start date set in the source file.

New/Ended

- New/Ended indicates a current year eligibility exists in the database. The new eligibility status from the source file is imported and the current year eligibility is ended. For example, an income, categorical or foster application with a start date prior to the start date set in the source file was already entered in the database; therefore the existing eligibility has to be ended the day prior to the start date of the imported eligibility. This is due to USDA requiring Direct Certification to take precedence over an income, categorical or foster application already on file for the current year. An application should not have been processed.

New/Removed

- New/Removed indicates a current year eligibility exists in the database. The new eligibility status from the source file was imported and the current year eligibility was removed. For example, an income, categorical or foster application with a start date the same as or later than the start date set in the source file was already entered in the database for the student, therefore the existing eligibility has to be removed since there cannot be two eligibilities existing for the same dates. This due to the USDA requiring Direct Certification to take precedence over any income, categorical or foster application already on file for the current year. An application should not have been processed. This will not remove the application from the database, only the eligibility associated with the application.

The Error/Warning section of the Import Report will not report any mismatches of data such as an incorrect date of birth, last name, first name, multiple student numbers or StateID's, missing data or incorrect file lengths.

The Existing Eligibility Records section will indicate if a current year Migrant, Runaway, Homeless or Direct Certification Eligibility Type exists in the database for a student and will not import a new Direct Certification eligibility for the student from the imported source file. These students will appear under the Existing section of the Import Report. This section indicates the student has a current year eligibility already and that someone will need to follow-up on the student to determine which Eligibility type should be indicated for the student for that year.

If the Exclude checkbox is selected, the Not Excluded and Excluded section will contain information. This checkbox will only exclude and report current year applications and not from previous years.

- Not Excluded indicates applications that were not excluded even though the Exclude checkbox was marked. There are a number of reasons why an application may not be excluded.
- If the application has more or less students than the import file, the application cannot be excluded. The import file must contain the same students as those existing on the application.
- If the application start date is prior to the start date set in the import file, the application cannot be excluded because the eligibility will have ended one day prior to the start date set in the import file.
- Excluded indicates applications that have the excluded flag set in Household Applications when the exclude checkbox is marked.
- An application is excluded if the start date falls on or after the start date set in the import file and all students on the application are included in the import file.

NOTE: An import cannot be undone once it has been imported. All records are updated upon completion of import. Users are advised to run a test prior to importing data.

NOTE: Each time an import is performed, the import file has to be edited to allow the file to be imported again. As it works right now, the Run an Import button does not function unless a new file is established each time the user wants to import a file. This is because each time an import is performed, the eligibility, eligibility type, school year, start date and date have to be set as well as the Exclude option if needed. The Import Wizard is currently being redesigned to allow for setting data after the mapping is saved as well as at the beginning of the mapping.

2010.1 ONLY

- A checkbox has been added to allow the use of header rows.
- A Date of Birth format has been added so the Last, First and Date of Birth mapping is used when a source file Date of Birth format type is selected. Date of Birth format will now map correctly to the Date of Birth format used in Campus.

Modifications Made to Eligibility and Household Application Editors (SIS-15431)

A number of modifications were made to the Eligibility and Household Application Editors. Because some modifications varied between different versions of Campus, the following lists modifications sorted by version:

Campus 2010.1

- Default Expiration Date has been added to FRAM Preferences. This allows districts to set a district-wide end date for all application and eligibility end dates. Users must be aware that this is an optional feature. The date entered will not affect Temporary Status end dates. If a date is entered, any application end date set using the Application Wizard or via Household Applications will auto-populate with the Default Expiration Date set.
- Some applications were being split into two eligibilities if an eligibility start date populated a student's eligibility either by adding an eligibility manually or via the Application Wizard or Household Applications. This has been corrected.
- Applications pulled into the Verification Sample or were Verified were incorrectly allowed to be deleted or excluded. This has been corrected.
- Users must be aware that Applications that have been Verified cannot be amended.
- Users were incorrectly able to edit an eligibility associated with an application. This has been corrected.

The Household Application Editor has been modified to now sort the Application List by Application Reference Number and start date, displaying the most recent application entered first.

- Users working within the Firefox web browser and using the Application Wizard were unable to process data on the final screen. This has been corrected.

Point of Sale

POS - Balance Letter Wizard Generated for Multiple Grade Levels (SIS-14728)

The Balance Letter Wizard was not printing information for all selected grade levels, only the lowest selected grade level. This has been corrected. All grade levels selected in the Balance Letter Wizard editor will be included in the generation of the letter.

Edit Check Report Modifications (SIS-15608)

The Edit Check Report has been modified to correct issues with Daily Participation totals and the state code sequence. Daily Participation totals were calculating using unrounded numbers which was causing the count to sometimes be incorrect. This has been corrected. Daily Participation totals are now the total of rounded numbers.

Also, the State Code sequence has been updated to now display NSLP information on the first page of the Edit Check Report and NSBP information on the second page.

POS Deposit - Comment Lengths and Voided Transactions (SIS-15770)

The POS Deposit tab was returning an error when a user voided a transaction and entered a comment. This has been corrected to allow a comment entry for a voided transaction up to 50 characters.

The display of voided transactions has been modified to display the voided information and the deposit date correctly.

Eligibility Fields Moved to Food Service in Ad hoc (SIS-15790)

Eligibility fields have been moved to Point of Sale > Account to Student > Food Service > Eligibility within Ad hoc. This change was necessary as users using FRAM would not have access to Eligibility fields in Ad hoc unless Point of Sale was enabled.

Along with moving these fields, two new fields were added to Eligibility. These fields include Application Name and Reference Number.

The POS Deposit, Cash Sale and Item Sale totals have been added back to the General Summary Section of the Transaction Summary Report.

Health

Health Conditions Alerts (SIS-13925)

Health Conditions have been rewritten to provide more security to student information and remove the ability for users to see certain health information for that student. The following is a summary of those changes:

System Administration Health

- A System Preference has been added to allow the display of health flags. When set to yes, any condition marked as flagged will appear as checked by default when that condition is assigned to a student and the flag will appear by the student's name. If this preference is turned off, the flag will not display next to the student's name even if the box is checked in the Condition for the student.
- A checkbox has been added to the interface for the health condition to be marked as being flagged when it is assigned to the student. If a condition is marked as flagged in System Administration but not marked as flagged for an individual student, no flag will appear.
- An Active checkbox has been added to Conditions to enable users to retire conditions that are no longer used. For a condition to be available for assignment to a student, this box must be selected.
- A System Preference has been added to allow users to use the Campus default conditions in addition to their custom conditions, or just their custom conditions. When set to no, the conditions that display will only be custom ones provided by the district.

System Administration Student Programs

- The Caduceus icon has been removed from the program dropdown list. Programs that used this icon will remain.
- The Medical program type has been removed and replaced with text directing a user to create a medical flag in Student Health Conditions.

Student Information Health Conditions

- A checkbox has been added to the interface to be used when a condition is assigned to a student that will make a health alert flag appear next to the student's name. Start and end dates can be entered to determine when the icon should display.

A text field has been added to collect user warning information for displaying the flag text. This is required when the Display Flag checkbox is marked.

- Checkboxes and labels for Auto-Accident related, Auto-Accident State, Employment Related and Other Accident Related have been removed.

- An Instructions text field has been added to alert the viewer to the proper care of the student who has a health condition.
- All existing condition values are marked as active.

Student Display

- A blue Emergency Medical Services (EMS) icon for a Condition Flag will display.
- All conditions will display a single flag next to the name. Hovering over the flag will display the alert information for all medical alert flags the student has, separated by a semi-colon.
- Selecting the new health condition flag will display a pop-up box that lists each health condition and instructions. Alert messages and instructions will also display.

Ad hoc Reporting

- Display Alert, User Warning and Instructions have been added to the Filter Designer.

Health - Document Upload Rights (SIS-14339)

Document upload rights for Health documents were reported to only be functional if the user also had read rights to the PLP document upload feature. This has been corrected to allow health documents to be uploaded without rights to PLP.

Medication Updates (SIS-15883)

Updates have to been made to Medication-related areas of Campus. The following is a list of updates made:

- Medication names now appear in alphabetical order on the Medication tab and in Medication Name.
- An Active checkbox has been added to Medication Name allowing users to activate or deactivate medications within Campus.
- The Amount per Dose field has been updated to allow values to two places after the decimal point (i.e., 1.XX).
- The Medication Strength field has been added to the Medication tab.
- Medication Strength information has been added to the Medication Summary Report. This information appears to the right of the medication name/form.

Section Summary Report (SIS-11279)

The Section Summary Report has been modified to increase the usability of the report. The following is a summary of the changes:

Report Editor

- The report editor has been changed to include new options and movement of existing options.

- The new Grading Task Grid options includes the ability to choose the following:
- Show Percent and Final Grade
- Show Percent Only
- Show Final Grade Only
- The Class average will not be calculated and displayed unless the Show Percent and Final Grade or Show Percent options are chosen.
- The same nesting structure as the teacher's Lesson Planner is now used on the Select Assignments list.
- All grading tasks now appear in bold type.
- Composite parent tasks now appear in bold italic type and in larger font so they stand out from regular grading tasks.
- All Task/Standard groups now appear in standard text in a slightly smaller font size.
- Assignments now appear in a regular font size, slightly smaller than assignment groups.
- Composite children grading tasks now include the percentage of the task, and uses the same formatting as the Lesson Planner.
- All tasks and groups in the active term will be selected by default. This is the current behavior.
- When a parent grading task is selected, all children of that task will also be selected (current behavior).
- The Random sort option has been removed.
- A new sorting option has been added, Student Person ID.
- If weighting on groups is used, the percent will display to the left of the group name in the select assignments list.

Report Display

- The Assignment Grade Column is now called the In-Progress Grade.
- The Assignment Average is now listed in Bold type.
- Alternate shading has been added to the rows in the grid table.
- Two tables have been created to display the posted Grading Task grades. The Legend table (first table) will list the Grading Tasks that make up the Grid table (second table).
- If no grading tasks are selected in the Assignment tree, the grading task tables will be hidden.
- A grading task will display in a separate set of tables using the Composite Legend and Grid only if the Parent Composite Grading Task is selected.
- Legends are sorted by Term.
- All decimals are to the nearest hundredth.

Modifications Made to Student Summary Report (SIS-14197)

A number of modifications have been made to the Student Summary Report. The following is a list of modifications made:

Grade Summary section has been added to the Student Summary Report editor. This new section features the following new checkboxes:

- Show Assignment Groups

- Show In-Progress Grade
- Show Final Grade
- Show Percentages
- Shade Alternate Rows

The Select Assignment list has been updated within the editor to better display grading tasks and composite grades. The name of this section has also changed. Select Assignment has become Select Grading Tasks, Standards and Assignments.

The description for the Student Summary Report editor has been updated.

A number of changes have been made to the Student Grade Summary Display on the report. The following lists changes made:

- The format of the Student Grade Summary has been modified to four columns. Column one contains Grading Tasks, Assignment Groups and Standards. Column two is called Total Points and displays point earned/points possible. Column three is called In-progress Grade and displays the percent and grade from the active gradebook. Column four is called Final Grade and displays posted grades.
- Assignment groups display in sequence number.
- All grades display exactly as they are entered in the grade book.
- All composite percent values display to the left of the corresponding task.
- Assignment group weights display to the left of the group name.
- Grade summary percentages now show two decimal places.

Changes were also made to the Assignment Display. The following is a list of changes made:

- All flags attached to assignments now display.
- Asterisks now displays in front of an assignment name if the assignment is not active, flagged as Ex or flagged as Dr.
