Infinite Campus to Double the Size of its Corporate Headquarters

September 29, 2015 - Blaine, Minn. - Infinite Campus is expanding its Corporate Headquarters in Blaine, Minnesota, with plans to increase its high tech workforce from 400 to well over 800 employees. Construction is already underway for the addition of a nine-story tower, connecting auditorium and parking structure.

“As our customer base grows, we continue to reinvest in the company with innovative product development, superior customer service and a vision for the future that takes us beyond the typical student information system (SIS),” says Charlie Kratsch, founder and CEO. “This building expansion and additional staff will help us achieve our mission of Transforming K12 Education®.”

Over 20 years, Infinite Campus has grown to serve 7.3 million students in 45 states with its fully-integrated student information system (SIS). It also manages student information for seven statewide solutions (South Dakota, Montana, Maine, Kentucky, Hawaii, Nevada and the Bureau of Indian Education). With more than 2,000 districts using Campus to manage student information, communicate with parents, impact classroom management and provide strategic direction for the future of education, Infinite Campus has become the most trusted name in student information.

Infinite Campus broke ground on its current building, aka the “Mothership” modeled after the Starship Enterprise, in 2007. Having been designed for 400 employees, it has now reached capacity as the company continues to grow.

In keeping with the theme of the Mothership, the new office Tower was inspired by the Vehicle Assembly Building (VAB) at NASA's Kennedy Space Center. The Tower will be a nine-story, 90,000 sq. ft. structure to accommodate increased staff, as well as a reinforced, state-of-the-art data center.

Connecting the Mothership and Tower is a 10,000 sq. ft., two-story auditorium that will provide expanded seating for the Campus restaurant and serve as a special event meeting space for up to 800 people. With unobstructed views of both Lochness Lake and a pond with fountains, the Connector will be an excellent place for employees and guests to congregate.

Construction is expected to be complete in December 2016.
